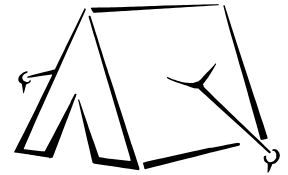

IF YOU WANT TO CHANGE SITES.....

If you wish to change sites, it is
ultimately your responsibility to
make sure that your Camper, as well
as any awnings and slide-outs, will
fit on the new site and not infringe
on the sites beside you.

Some sites will take bigger Campers
while other sites may be too small.
Management will assist in making
that determination.

A site list is kept by Gleta Edwards,
KRC manager. A copy of the site
list is also kept by Mackey!

If you are interested in getting a
different site at KRC, please stop
by and put your name on the list.
Once the site becomes available,
the list will freeze and persons on
the list will be contacted. The first
ones to be called will be shareholders.
If no shareholders want the
site or there are no shareholders on
the list, non-shareholders will be
called. If a non-shareholder gets
the site, and it is not a shareholder
site, then that Camper can stay on
that site as long as they pay the
monthly fee and deposit for the
following year.
